Union Gas expands service station business; opens 2nd Cnergy service station at 743 Dunman Road with more in pipeline

- *Celebrated the Grand Opening of new Dunman Road service station by donating all proceeds from the event, which was supported by members of the local Lamborghini Club.*
- *Union Gas has been awarded two additional service station sites at Queensway and Marsiling, which are expected to open in 2026 and 2027 respectively, and expects to add more to its pipeline.*

SINGAPORE, 7 October 2025 – Leading fuel products provider, **Union Gas Holdings Limited** (优联燃气控股有限公司) (“**Union Gas**” or together with its subsidiaries, the “**Group**”), has officially opened its second service station at 743 Dunman Road under its “Cnergy” brand yesterday. This is the Group’s second Cnergy station after the first one located at 50 Old Toh Tuck Road, which has been operating since 2009.

Inspired by the vibrant Peranakan heritage of the neighbourhood, the Dunman Road Cnergy station embraces this cultural theme throughout its premise. A highlight is “An Ode to Joo Chiat”, a vibrant mural by Victor Emmanuel, Stellah Lim and Marcel Gaspar, which celebrates shophouse life, Peranakan heritage and the community spirit of Singapore in the 1950s through to the 60s. The station is equipped with a total of 26 nozzles: 16 for petrol, eight for diesel and two for electric vehicle charging.

The Grand Opening event was supported by members of the Lamborghini Club Singapore, who roared up to the station in their top marques to fuel up. Union Gas donated all proceeds from the event to the Kidney Dialysis Foundation to serve the needs of kidney patients.

Union Gas has also announced plans to expand its Cnergy brand to other locations in Singapore. The Group has been awarded two other service station sites at Queensway and Marsiling, which are expected to open in 2026 and 2027 respectively.

Mr Teo Hark Piang, CEO of Union Gas, said: *“While our existing station at 50 Old Toh Tuck Road serves mainly commercial vehicles, the new one at 743 Dunman Road will enable us to serve a wider community and diverse group of drivers. It will also be the blueprint for future Cnergy stations, which will focus on delivering a unique customer experience and offering a variety of fuelling and EV charging options. With two more stations opening soon, we believe our Cnergy brand will gain greater recognition and this will lead to more opportunities to operate in multiple locations across Singapore. As we gradually expand our network of service stations, we expect it to contribute positively to our topline.”*

The Group also provides liquefied NG and piped NG to industrial customers and distributes compressed NG primarily to natural gas vehicles via its service station as well as to industrial customers for their commercial use.
